Prof. Vincenzo TUFARELLI

Vincenzo Tufarelli is Associate Professor of Animal Nutrition and Feeding (AGR/18), at the Department of Precision and Regenerative Medicine and Ionian Area - (DiMePRe-J), Section of Veterinary Sciences and Animal Production, of the University of Bari "Aldo Moro", Italy. Prof. Tufarelli obtained the degree in Veterinary Medicine and a PhD in Animal Nutrition from the "Aldo Moro" University of Bari.

He is currently Head of the Post-graduate School of "Pathology and Technology of Poultry, Rabbit and Game Species" of the University of Bari "Aldo Moro", Italy.

The topics of interest are related to animal and poultry nutrition and feeding, with particular reference to the use of feeds/foods with nutraceutical value, the use of natural additives in animal diet, the valorisation of by-products of the agrifood industry in animal feeding, and on qualitative evaluation of animal production.

Of particular importance was the study of feed production technologies containing alternative energy and protein sources and their impact on the performance of species of zootechnical interest. Furthermore, the scientific production has focused on the valorisation of national grain legumes technologically treated through decortication, micronization and air classification processes in order to replace soybean meal in the diet of the main livestock species, while supporting performance and health. He has also conducted studies relating to the effects of using extra virgin olive oil with a high content of polyphenols in poultry diet.

Prof. Tufarelli obtained the certificate of participation in the advanced course in Statistics in Animal Sciences at the University of Perugia (Italy) and the University of Sassari (Italy) organized by ASPA (Italian Scientific Association of Animal Production), and the Advanced Course in Poultry Production in the Mediterranean Environment, organized by the Mediterranean Agronomic Institute of Zaragoza (Spain), International Center for Advanced Mediterranean Agronomic Studies.

He has established scientific collaboration relationships with foreign research institutes.

He is a member of the editorial board of indexed scientific journals placed in the first quartile (Q1).

He is a member of panels of experts for the evaluation of European and International research projects.

He is a member of: the World's Poultry Science Association - Italian Branch); the American Society of Animal Science; and the Association for Animal Science and Production (ASPA).

He is Scientific Responsible for International Academic Agreements between the University of Bari Aldo Moro and other foreign institutions.

Prof. Tufarelli holds the National Scientific Qualification (ASN) to hold the role of Full Professor for the scientific sector Animal Science and Technology (07/G1).
